Circular

In view of the recent circular issued by the Principal, the students are requested to follow the guidelines as given below on their return to the hostel and their stay thereafter.

1. Every student is expected to report to the hostel after getting the first dose of the Covid-19 vaccine and should submit the certificate to the hostel Manager/ Supervisor.
2. Producing a Covid-19 RT-PCR negative report (with a 72 Hours validity) at the time of reporting at the hostel is mandatory. Rapid Antigen Test [RAT] is not accepted.
3. Before commencing travel, it is mandatory to fill the details of travel in the Google Form available at <https://forms.gle/u1CeLZoqNppx6ov79>
4. The high-risk individuals (Comorbid conditions) will have to mandatorily wear an N95 mask at all times in the hostel and college premises.
5. Students are advised to carry good number of 3 ply mask and hand sanitizers before they start their travel.
6. If any student become symptomatic (fever, dry cough, sore throat, running nose, headache, body ache, loose stools, loss of smell and taste) on arrival, he will be shifted to the hospital for further management as earmarked by the Institution. Should follow all quarantine protocols prevailing at the time of arrival at their own expenses.
7. Strictly, 6 (six) feet distance to be maintained between students while conversing with other students, food suppliers. The arrangements of beds, tables, chairs in the rooms, reading room and mess should not be altered.
8. Students are instructed to maintain personal hygiene by regular hand washing with soap and water (at least for 40 - 60 seconds) or using hand sanitizers with 70% alcohol (at least for 20 seconds) for every 2 hours.
9. Wear 3-ply masks in hostel common areas. 3 ply masks are effective if worn properly fitted, covering mouth and nose. Masks should be discarded in the appropriate bins provided in the hostel general area and changed if they become physically damaged or soaked. Used mask should be considered as potentially infected medical waste.

10. Keep room windows and doors open whenever possible to make sure the rooms in hostels are well ventilated.
11. Respiratory etiquettes to be strictly followed. This involves strict practice of covering one's mouth and nose while coughing/sneezing with a tissue/handkerchief/flexed elbow and disposing off used tissues properly.
12. Hostels may define the number of students in dining halls at any point of time. Mess timings may be increased to avoid overcrowding. Physical distancing should be maintained in all areas of hostel.
13. Anyone with even a mild symptoms of COVID 19 infection should be immediately reported to hostel manager / supervisors to seek medical care.
14. Isolation / medical treatment will be arranged as required in case of Covid symptoms.
15. When there is no academic activities at the Institute, movement of hostel students outside College Campus is restricted. Every in and out movement of the student from the hostel need to be registered in the specified format provided by the hostel.
16. Students are permitted and encouraged to avail the sports and fitness facility available inside the College Campus under the supervision of physical directors. Hostel inmates are permitted to use these facilities during 6:00am to 8:30am in the morning and from 4:30pm to 6:30pm in the evening. Yoga classes are held in the Reading Hall from 6.45am to 7.30 am.
17. For any requirement of items that are not available in the cooperative stores in the campus, the students can make use of the time slots mentioned above, after taking permission from the respective Hostel Managers. Medical Shop, exclusive fresh fruit shops and multiple grocery shops have started in the near vicinity of the hostel.
18. Maintaining social distancing, wearing mask and following SOP is mandatory in the hostel and college campus.
